GOJ Sanctions on Russia

The GOJ announces new measures on Tuesday: 1) ban on new investments, effective May 12; 2) ban on loans longer than a year to RUS companies; 3) asset freeze on 398 individuals and 28 organizations, and on Sberbank and Alfabank (May 12); and 4) ban on certain imports of alcoholic beverages, machinery and electronics (April 19).

First Japan-Philippines "2+2"

The foreign and defense ministers of Japan and the Philippines met for the first-ever "2+2" meeting on Saturday. The two sides agreed to strengthen coordination on regional and global issues. The ministers also discussed possible reciprocal visits and reciprocal provision of supplies and services to enhance cooperation between the JSDF and Armed Forces.

<u>LDP Proposal for Defense/Security</u> Document Revision

The LDP's draft proposal regarding the revision of the NSS, NDPG and MTDP revealed Friday included a new goal of defense spending over 2 percent of GDP within the next 5 years; mentioning the acquisition of and renaming "enemy base strike capabilities" in the NSS; and updating the language on China and Russia to reflect the greater threat both countries pose.

New Variant "XE" Confirmed

The health ministry announced Monday that the first case of the new variant "XE" was confirmed in Japan. Research suggests "XE" is likely to be 12.6 percent more transmissible than BA.2. PM Kishida Fumio told reporters Wednesday that there is no immediate need to reinstate preemergency measures.
