Japan-PRC Summit

On Thursday, Prime Minister Kishida Fumio met with Chinese President Xi Jinping in Thailand for the first summit-level meeting in three years.

Kishida underscored the importance of the two great nations forming a "constructive and stable" relationship to tackle common issues. Xi responded that he would like to form bilateral relations that meet the demands of a new era.

The leaders agreed on the early convening of a high-level economic dialogue and high-level people-to-people and cultural exchange dialogue.

Japan-U.S.-ROK Summit

On Sunday, Kishida held a trilateral summit meeting with **President Joe Biden** and **President Yoon Suk-yeol**.

Among other things, the leaders strongly condemned North Korea's unprecedented number of ballistic missile launches, and agreed to share real-time missile warning data, as well as establish a new economic security dialogue.

Another Minister Sacked

On Monday, Kishida announced that former foreign minister Matsumoto Takeaki will replace Terada Minoru as Minister of Internal Affairs and Communications.

Terada was **sacked** after several weeks of questioning by the opposition and media about **multiple campaign finance** violations

He becomes the **third minister** in the second Kishida Cabinet to be sacked (**Yamagiwa Daishiro** and **Hanashi Yasuhiro**).
