### G7 Virtual Leaders' Summit

On Wednesday, Prime Minister Kishida Fumio hosted an online G7 summit. The summit was attended by Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy.

The G7 leaders committed to step up efforts against Russia's actions in Ukraine and condemned Hamas's terror attacks on Israel, urging the immediate release of all remaining hostages.

The leaders renewed their commitment to advancing international discussions on inclusive artificial intelligence (AI) governance and interoperability between AI governance frameworks. They also committed to working together for further advancing the Data Free Flow with Trust (DFFT).

# Over Fundraising Scandal

On December 11, Hokkaido Shimbun reported that Kishida is planning to reshuffle the Cabinet and LDP leadership on December 14, once the extraordinary Diet session comes to an end, to remove all Abe faction members from senior leadership positions.

The latest report suggests that at least ten Abe faction members received several hundred million in kickbacks for excess fundraising party ticket sales above quotas. The kickbacks have been characterized as a norm created over decades.

Main opposition Constitutional Democratic Party submitted a no-confidence motion against Chief Cabinet Secretary Matsuno Hirokazu and the Cabinet.

Prosecutors have brought in Abe faction staff and lawmaker secretaries for questioning.
